What is the ultimate superpower; one that implies all others?


This is a story of people unwittingly given the power to hack the laws of physics, the very fabric of reality.

Research at the University of Pennsylvania inspired this. They developed an artificial virus that cures congenital blindness.

#### A coworker, Alessandra Giancana, catches the virus from him.

"Allie G" is the acting head of art and animation at the videogame company where she and Derek work. Her parents emigrated from Taormina, Sicily.

Her grandfather is a Mafia don. Her father and younger brother were killed in a war with a rival gang. She blames her grandfather and *despises* "Mafia Culture."

She grew up in Brooklyn and is an artistically talented but streetwise New York woman who advised a friend that "men are chickenshit."

Think Marisa Tomei in "My Cousin Vinny."

#### Soon, Derek and Allie can both soar through the spiritworld

Note: the special effects here are minimal (basically a movingpicture version of photoshop). It's a slow-reveal as our two protagonists discover the consequence of this super-power:

1. They can summon their *physical* bodies, i.e. they can *teleport*.

thoughts are sounds in the spirit world, i.e. they can hear thoughts.

3. As time passes, they discover other superpowers in crisis situations.

#### Vladimir Ustinov, the Russian mobster who financed Pembroke's research wants his due


### He wants more than mere money, though.

He became the leader of a criminal gang in New York.

As a former scientist, he's fascinated by the virus that infected Derek and Allie. He also feels he paid for it, so it's his.

### The mob attempts to kidnap Derek's family.

Derek and Allie discover a new superpower: they can reset from injuries. They teleport-in-place to an earlier (uninjured) version of themselves.

The only downside is momentary amnesia.

#### Our protagonists and their families flee to the north shore of Oahu.


From there, they scan the gangsters and give the police perfect "anonymous" tips. This costs the Ustinov mob hundreds of millions

The Chechen will stage a terrorist attack that only Derek can prevent — by cooperating with Ustinov.


In return Ustinov will give the Chechen "regime change in Mother Russia."

Mount bombs on 100 long-haul flights:




#### Ustinov can disable all but one, if Derek submits to a brain biopsy
